slickFISH Lures

Designed to mimic the action of a wounded baitfish, a slickFISH lure falls slowly and stays in the strike longer where it catches the attention of predator fish, such as reds and trout. What the fish don't see though are any signs of hooks protruding from the lure. Hidden inside the body of the lure are twin retractable hooks that will be released when a fish strikes. With no exposed hooks, the lure can be easily worked through grass, over reefs and around other structure without fear of hanging up.

The slickFISH comes in a variety of body colors as well as tail colors that can be purchased separately.

Red Fish on a Fly


